## Campus Preparedness Committee Charge

The Board of Directors charges the Campus Preparedness Committee with the assessment and monitoring of campus issues related to the physical safety of the FUUN community. This ongoing safety work includes but is not necessarily limited to the following:

Develop and implement safety drills for emergencies such as fires or tornadoes; Set up and maintain medical equipment/supplies (i.e.: first aid kits, AED devices, etc.); Sponsor workshops, trainings and/or RE classes on safety issues; Create procedures for safety issues like door locks and keys or inclement weather

closures;

Provide suggestions to the board on new policies and/or revisions to policies or by-laws that would enhance campus safety; and

Manage situations that may endanger the safety of the congregation such as disruptive visitors or members.
