## **Committee for the Larger Faith Charge**

## **Purpose**

The Committee for the Larger Faith is the congregation's link to all the activities of the Unitarian Universalist Association (UUA) and the Southern Region of which we are a part. The committee helps to publicize meetings and workshops presented by both groups and assists in informing the congregation about news and events concerning the broader Unitarian-Universalist movement.

## Responsibilities include:

- Recruit, vet, and select delegates for General Assembly (GA) and present their names and qualifications to the Board; work with Worship Committee to have congregation ratify delegates;
- 2. Following GA, notify the congregation of the activities and actions of the assembly and determine how/whether to implement specific recommendations and programs of that body;
- 3. In collaboration with the Social Justice Committee, organize the way our congregation responds to study action issues;
- 4. Organize annual Guest at Your Table campaign for the Unitarian Universalist Service Committee (UUSC);
- 5. Serve as contact for The Mountain Retreat and Learning Center;
- As part of our annual certification process to UUA, ensure notification of our congregation's preferences on association issues;
- 7. Communicate with the congregation, its board, committees and members about activities that support Unitarian Universalism outside of FUUN;
- 8. Submit an annual budget request and monitor expenses against established budget;
- 9. Send monthly reports to the Program Council Chair, attend regular Program Council meetings and submit an annual report in May.
